This mainly concerns the UK Emission Trading Scheme (UK ETS), but also covers the Energy Saving and Opportunities Scheme (ESOS) and Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR), as well as the new Taskforce for Climate Related Financial Disclosures (TCFD).

UK ETS duties and responsibilities:

- Building and maintaining strong, professional working relationships with all clients, verifiers, and the Regulator.
- Ensuring clients understand their ETS responsibilities.
- Managing ETSWAP on behalf of the client for permit applications, notifications, and variations to ensure ETS obligations are met.
- Gathering, cleaning, and processing data from clients,
- Carrying out energy and emissions calculations
- Submitting Annual Emission Monitoring, Improvement and Activity Level Reports.
- Supporting clients through verification, whether virtual or onsite.
- Ensuring Swan is up to date on ETS developments and changes.

Other possible duties:

- Calculating energy and emission figures and report writing for other schemes including, but not limited to SECR and ESOS.
- Writing blog articles/content for the website.

- Managing Swan Energy's suppliers i.e., website developers, publishers, utilities, and travel companies. Inputting into the overall strategy of the business.
- Attending/presenting at industry events.
